- Foreign participants will have to provide a valid affiliation card from their association and a photo ID.
- Athletes competing on Sunday, in the same weight category, will not have to weigh in a second time. However, they must notify logistics as soon as possible in the event of a withdrawal.

REGISTRATION

REGISTRATION

Athletes who wish to participate in a second division must pre-register for all the desired categories. No registration will be done on site.

Until Friday November 6th 2026, 23:59 : Standard rate based on division

From November 7 to November 8, 23:59 : 30\$ additional fees depending on the division

Additional fee of 50\$ for any registration accepted after registration has completely closed (subject to approval by the tournament director)

Judo Québec can manage exceptional cases.

- 40\$ fees for each additional division (2nd or 3rd division). 60\$ per division if registered between November 7 and 8, 2026.
- Athletes registered in a 2nd age division must confirm their withdrawal from the tournament as soon as possible at the logistics (accreditation table).
- Athletes who do not make the weight at the weigh-in will automatically be placed in the actual weight category at no charge.
- A \$50 fee will be charged to the participant's club for any error in registration regarding grade or age division that is discovered after the first draw.
- A \$15 administration fee will be deducted from all cancellations made before Thursday November 12.
- No refunds will be given for cancellations made on or after Friday November 13 for any reason.

COACHES

Coaches must register online in advance to obtain their accreditation card by Friday, November 6, 2026. Online registration is MANDATORY for ALL coaches.

- A 20\$ fee will be charged to obtain a coaching accreditation after November 6, 2026.
- A coaches meeting will be held Saturday November 14 at 8 :00 am.
- To be accredited, a coach must be trained as a « dojo instructor » or NCCP 2 CERTIFIED.
- Coaches are required to adhere to the following dress code: long pants, shoes, shirt/t-shirt/golf shirt/polo and no hat.
- Coaches will need a smart phone or tablets to look at the draws on www.judocanada.live.

ACCESS

- Access to the competition area reserved for athletes will be granted to coaches with accreditation and athletes in judogi.

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- There is a fee of \$10 per day for spectator access to the competition.
- No bag will be aloud in the competition area. Also, for cleanliness reasons, no food or beverage will be aloud in the competition area. All bags not in the designated places will be moved.

REFEREES

- Referees must be members of Judo Quebec, another Canadian association or of a recognize IJF association.
- Referees from outside Quebec must register online [xxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxlien inscription arbitrexxxxxxxxxx](#) and for any question, contact François Noël at tournoi@judo-quebec.qc.ca.
- Registration: before Thursday October 29, 2026
- All referees must be certified NATIONAL A or above.
- There will be a referees meeting Friday evening at 7:30 pm at the hôtel Royal Versailles (7200 rue Sherbrooke Est, Montréal, Qc). À CONFIRMER and at the same time on Zoom. Coaches are welcome to attends as well. Referee suit mandatory.

TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1- IJF rules and/or Judo Canada rules will be applied.
- 2- Arm-locks are forbidden in U16 age division (U16 athlete meeting early bloomer clause and entering an older age division will be subject to the older age groups regulations).
- 3- Modified double elimination system and/or pool depends on the number of registrations.
- 4- Tournament's software will be used to make the draw prior to the competition and will be available at www.judocanada.live.
- 5- Organizing committee can modify certain weight categories should there be too few athletes in a division or category.
- 6- The competition will take place on 7 different 7m X 7m mat surfaces.
- 7- White and blue judogis are mandatory for U16 and over (white-blue reversible judogi are not aloud).
- 8- Athletes can only fight in one age division per day, except those fighting in the ne waza category.
- 9- It is strictly forbidden to lend his coaching accreditation, otherwise this coach will lose his right to coach, for the duration of the tournament.
- 10- Any request for an exemption for early bloomer must be submitted to and processed by Judo Canada before the end of the tournament registration period.
- 11- **Athletes who do not show up for the weigh-in will be automatically withdrawn and no refund will be applicable.**
- 12- Medalists must present themselves in white judogi during the medal ceremony (no accessories allowed on the podium, e.g. flag, hat, etc.).

LENGTH OF MATCHES

- U16-Master: 3 min.
- U18-U21-Senior-Ne waza: 4 min.
- Golden Score will be apply if necessary in all divisions.
