U18, U21 and masters athletes who also fight in senior division Sunday (in the same weight category) will **NOT** have to go on the scale again. They will however go to the weigh-inn on Saturday after-noon just to confirm that they still want to participate in the senior division.



- 2- ONCE WE REACH 850 PARTICIPANTS, THE SUBSCRIPTION SITE WILL BE CLOSED AND THEREFORE IT WILL BE IMPOSSIBLE TO REGISTER MORE ATHLETES.
- 3- ATHLETES WHO WANT TO SUBSCRIBE IN TWO AGE DIVISIONS HAVE TO REGISTER ONLINE IN BOTH AGE DIVISIONS. NO REGISTRATION WILL BE ALLOWED ON SITE.

REGISTRATION COSTS

\$15 administrative fees will be taken for all subscription cancelation after October 28th regardless of what the reason might be.

E.IGIBI.ITY

- 1-Be a member of a provincial judo association, of Judo Canada or of an association recognized by the IJF.
- Trainers must be at least certified NCCP 1 or dojo assistant instructor.

RULES AND COMPETITION SYSTEM

- Modified double elimination system for all age division (U16, U18, U21, seniors and masters).
- PRAGMA's tournament software will be used for draw before the competition.
- Golden score will apply in U16, U18, U21 and senior division.
- Blue judogi is mandatory (or white-blue reversible).
- IJF tournaments rules and/or Judo Canada's will be applied.
- Arm-locks are forbidden for U16 age division.
- Athletes can only fight in one age division per day.
- U16 can only fight in their own age division (they cannot fight in two divisions).

For U16, U18, U21 and senior Quebecois competitors the Quebec Open is one of the qualification tournaments for the National Championship. Quebec Open is a tournament that gives regional points in senior division (Judo Canada).
