**Sunday, March 15, 2020** - U14 Team Competition, U16, Intermediate & Seniors.

9:00 am start for U14 Team Competition; U16, Intermediate and Senior to follow. Last event will be Senior Mixed Team Competition (pending sufficient participation).

\*\*If there is sufficient response there will be a Senior Mixed Team Competition against Tokai University, \$600 Cash Prize for the First Place Team. The current IJF tournament and the Judo Canada rules will apply.

- The rules will be reviewed at the coaches & referee clinic
- Blue & White judogis are mandatory for ALL divisions - IJF labelled gi's are not mandatory, but as the Pac is a JC Regional points tournament, athletes must follow the Judo Canada judogi guidelines in JCTS 13.2 & 13.3.1
- Judo Canada back patch rules will apply
- Arm locks are not permitted for U16 divisions
- No Shime-waza & Kansetsu-waza allowed in the U14 and Intermediate Senior Women's division involving Orange belts.
- Golden Score will be applied for all divisions except U14
- Modified double elimination for divisions with more than 5 contestants,
- Round-robin for divisions with 5 or less contestants
- The gold medal match in the winner's bracket will determine first and second place.

## TEAM COMPETITION

The Tournament Director reserves the right to alter the Intermediate and Ne-waza Men and Women's weight divisions if the numbers in these divisions warrant such changes. The IJF Team Competition guidelines will be followed.

### U14 TEAM COMPETITION

3 Female: -40kg, -48kg & +48kg

3 Male: -42kg, -50kg & +50kg

## SENIOR TEAM COMPETITION

3 Female: -57kg, -63kg & +63kg

3 Male: -66kg, -90kg & +90kg

Please note team weight divisions maybe modified based on weight division of eligible participants. The weight category is the maximum weight that an athlete can be to fight in that category. Lighter team athletes can fight up a weight division to a maximum of weight difference of 15%. Registration for the team competition will take place on Sunday morning at the competition site.
