- Foreign participants will have to provide a valid affiliation card from their association and a photo ID.
- Athletes competing on Sunday, in the same weight category, will not have to weigh in a second time. However, they will have to confirm their participation on Saturday, November 5th at the logistic.

Important: Each participant must present an ID (with photo for 16 years and over). Athletes fighting on Sunday, in the same weight division, will not have to weigh a second time. However, they will have to confirm their participation on Saturday November 5th at the tournament logistic.

Foreign participants will have to provide a valid affiliation card from their association and a photo ID.

REGISTRATION

REGISTRATION

Athletes who wish to participate in a second division must pre-register for all the desired categories. No registration will be done on site. Inscription.judocanada.org/event/guebecopen2023

Until friday November 3 2023, 23:59: Regular rates apply
From November 4 to November 5, 23:59: 10\$ Late fee / division
Additional fee of 35\$ for any registration accepted after
registration has completely closed (subject to acceptance
by the tournament organizers).

Judo Québec can manage exceptional cases.

- 40\$ fees for each additional division.
- Athletes registered in a 2nd division must confirm their participation in the second division with logistics before the end of the weigh-in on Saturday.
- Athletes who do not make the weight at the weigh-in will automatically be placed in the actual weight category at no charge.
- A \$20 fee will be charged for any grade or age division registration errors found after the 1st draw.
- A \$15 administration fee will be charged for all cancellations made between October 30 and November 5.
- No refunds will be given for cancellations made on or after November 6 for any reason.
- A 15\$ fee will be charge to obtain a coaching accreditation after November 5.

COACHES

- Coaches must pre-register online to obtain their credential card by November 5, 2023. Online registration for ALL coaches MANDATORY. http://inscription.judocanada.org/event/quebecopen2023coach
- A coaches meeting will be held Saturday November 11 at 7:30 am.
- To be accredited, a coach must be trained as a « dojo instructor » or NCCP 2 CERTIFIED.
- Coaches are required to adhere to the following dress code: long pants, shoes, shirt/t-shirt/golf shirt/polo and no hat.
- Coaches will need a smart phone or tablets to look at the draws on <u>www.judocanada.live</u> .

ACCESS

- Access to the competition area reserved for athletes will be granted to coaches with accreditation and athletes in judogi. Online pre-registration for all athletes and coaches is MANDATORY.
- Access to the stands are free for all spectators.
- No bag will be aloud in the competition area. Also, for cleanliness reasons, no food or beverage will be aloud in the competition area. All bags not in the designated places will be moved.



REFEREES

- Referees must be members of Judo Quebec, another Canadian association or of a recognize IJF association.
- Referees from outside Quebec must register online
 http://inscription.judocanada.org/event/quebecopen2023coach and
 confirm their presence to François Noël before October 23, 2023 at tournoi@judo-quebec.qc.ca.
- All referees must be certified NATIONAL A or above.
- There will be a referees meeting Friday evening at 7:30 pm at the competition venue and at the same time on Zoom. Coaches are welcome to attends as well. Referee suit mandatory.

TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1- IJF rules and/or Judo Canada rules will be applied.
- 2- All submissions (strangulations and arm-locks), Drop Seoi Nage and Sankaku are forbidden for the U14 age division (U14 athlete meeting early bloomer clause and entering an older age division will be subject to the older age groups regulations).
- 3- Arm-locks are forbidden in U16 age division (U16 athlete meeting early bloomer clause and entering an older age division will be subject to the older age groups regulations).
- 4- Modified double elimination system and/or pool depends on the number of registrations.
- 5- Tournament's software will be used to make the draw prior to the competition and will be available at www.judocanada.live.
- 6- Organazing committee can modify certain weight categories should there be too few athletes in a division or category.
- 7- The competition will take place on 7 different 8mX8m mat surfaces.
- 8- Fighting with a single white judogi will be accepted for the U14 division only.
- 9- White and blue judogis are mandatory for U16 and over (white-blue reversible judogi are not aloud).
- 10-Athletes can only fight in one age division per day, except those fighting in the ne waza category.
- 11-It is strictly forbidden to lend his coaching accreditation, otherwise this coach will lose his right to coach, for the duration of the tournamenent.
- 12-All requests for athletes born in 2011 or later to fight in another age division must sent to tournoi@judo-quebec.qc.ca by October 30th, 2023. All applications must come with a recap of past results and the early-bloomer waiver. All applications will be forwarded to Judo Canada.
- 13- Athletes who do not show up for the weigh-in will be automatically withdrawn and no refund will be applicable.
- 14- Medalists must present themselves in white judgai during the medal ceremony.

LENGTH OF MATCHES

- U14-U16-Master: 3 min.
- U18-U21-Senior-Ne waza: 4 min.



Golden Score will apply for all divisions except for U14. in the
absence of technical points or in the case of a tied technical score at
the end of the fight, the winner will be determined as follows: if a
shido has been awarded, the winner will be the fighter with the
fewest shidos; if there is a tie regarding shidos, the winner will be
determined by a decision of the referees.

NOTICE FOR QUEBEC AND CANADIANS JUDOKAS

- For the quebec members, this tournament is one of the qualifiers for the U16, U18, U21, Senior, Master and Ne Waza Nationals. The tournament also count towards the provincial ranking of the U14 division.
- Quebec Open's senior and junior (U21) division gives Canadian athletes points toward Judo Canada's ranking system.
- The Quebec Open is also a tournament that serves as a qualifier for the 2024 U18 Elite Nationals for all Canadian athletes.
